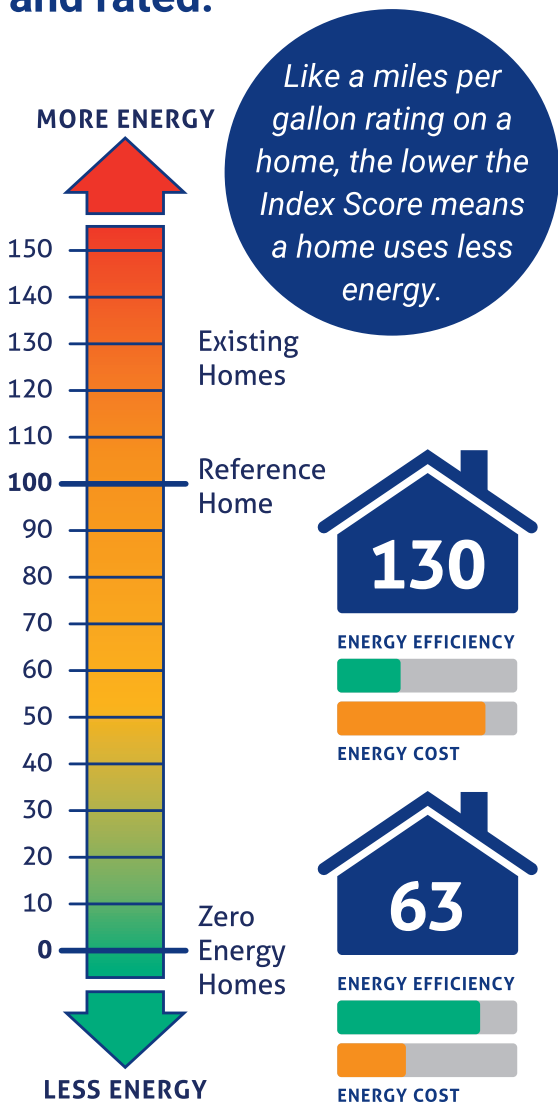


HERS® Index

The HERS® Index is the national standard by which a home's energy efficiency is inspected and rated.



All HERS Ratings are stored in the RESNET® National Buildings Registry and subject to quality assurance.
