Comment/Explanation*:

Include your justification for your proposed change to the draft standard below.

At many points in the current draft standard, “*construction documents*” are referred to and those are defined as “*Written, graphic and pictorial documents prepared or assembled for describing the design, location and physical characteristics of the elements of a project necessary for obtaining a building permit.*” in the Definitions section. This definition is insufficient because the documents required to obtain a building permit, more often than not, do not accurately depict what is actually approved to be built by the architect or engineer of record and what is actually built.

Therefore, I propose the definition of “construction documents” be improved as proposed below.

Proposed Change to the Draft Standard*

Use “~~strikethrough~~” and “underline” formatting to indicate all proposed changes. Changes must be shown with “hard-formatting” ~~strikethrough~~ and underline, not “track changes”.

Use a color other than red to indicate proposed changes to the draft.

Construction documents – *Written, graphic and pictorial documents prepared or assembled for describing the design, location and physical characteristics of the elements of a project necessary for obtaining a building permit* AND FOR ACHIEVING SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION AND FINAL COMPLETION. CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS SHALL INCLUDE PRODUCT SUBMITTALS APPROVED BY THE ARCHITECT AND/OR ENGINEER OF RECORD.
