At many points in the current draft standard, "construction documents" are referred to and those are defined as "Written, graphic and pictorial documents prepared or assembled for describing the design, location and physical characteristics of the elements of a project necessary for obtaining a building permit." in the Definitions section. This definition is insufficient because the documents required to obtain a building permit, more often than not, do not accurately depict what is actually approved to be built by the architect or engineer of record and what is actually built.

Therefore, I propose the definition of "construction documents" be improved as proposed below.

CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS SHALL INCLUDE PRODUCT SUBMITTALS</u> <u>APPROVED BY THE ARCHITECT AND/OR ENGINEER OF RECORD.</u>
